2. Winners under the age of 18 must be accompanied by a parent or guardian when claiming and collecting their prize. Photographic identification may be required upon collection of the prize.
3. Photographs submitted must be the entrant's own original work.
4. A maximum of three entries per person will be accepted in each category.
5. Photographs must meet the photographic categories in order to be eligible.
6. By submitting a photograph, the entrant grants the Yorke Peninsula Council and it's entities a royalty free, perpetual licence to use, reproduce, publish or display the photographs and any accompanying stories in relation to the entrants. This permission extends without limitation to any online media format and publications as deemed suitable by the Yorke Peninsula Council. This includes commercial purposes and may extend to or involve use by or with one or more third parties.
7. Images may be published on promotional material, in displays, exhibitions, and websites and any other print and electronic media and publications promoting the Yorke Peninsula Council region.
8. Each image is to be saved with a file name in the following format: Image Location_Photographer Name. (e.g. PtVincent_John Smith; if multiples at the same location: PtVincent1_John Smith; PtVincent2_John Smith)
9. Images are not to be manipulated or doctored in any form to create a false image. Cropping, cleaning, levels and curve adjustments are acceptable if minimal. Collages, text overlapping or significant enhancements will not be accepted.
10. Talent release forms must be completed and submitted with your entry form for each identifiable person in the photograph. Without this form your application will become ineligible. Talent release forms are available from Yorke Peninsula Visitor Information Centre – email info@visityorkepeninsula.com.au for the forms.
11. Photographs that feature any corporate advertising material or messages will be disqualified from entry.
12. All entries will be judged and rated on photographic merit by a panel selected by the Yorke Peninsula Council Visitor Information Centre. The judging panel's decision is final and cannot be contested. The panel will be judging the photos on the following criteria:
 - a) Creativity – unique views of buildings and people
 - b) Composition – consideration of alignment and perspective
 - c) Vibrancy – embrace colour and light quality
 - d) Demonstration of Yorke Peninsula in a positive manner
13. From all of the entries received, judges will select 13 images – one to represent each category plus one extra. The selected photographs will be displayed at Yorke Peninsula Visitor Information Centre, 29 Main Street Minlaton.
14. The photographers of the 13 selected images will be notified by a representative of the Yorke Peninsula Visitor Information Centre and the selected images will be displayed on Yorke Peninsula Visitor Centre's Facebook page between Friday 1st July and Sunday 23rd July 2017.

15. **People's Choice Award** – The public will be invited to vote for their favourite of the selected images, with the image receiving the most votes winning the major prize - a voucher for Yorke Peninsula Council's Holiday Parks to the value of \$150.00.
16. To vote for the People's Choice Award visit the Yorke Peninsula Visitor Information Centre Facebook page www.facebook.com/YorkePeninsulaVisitorCentre between Friday 1st July and Sunday 23rd July 2017.
17. A link to the Facebook voting page will be available on the Yorke Peninsula Visitor Information Centre website – www.visityorkepeninsula.com.au, and the Yorke Peninsula Council website – www.yorke.sa.gov.au
18. The winner of the People's Choice Award will be announced on Monday 24th July 2017 and will be notified by a representative of the Yorke Peninsula Visitor Information Centre. The winner will be announced online www.visityorkepeninsula.com.au on Tuesday 25th July 2017.
